








Key Phonics Terms

Grapheme	A letter or group of letters representing a single phoneme.	S
Phoneme	The smallest unit of sound in a word that changes the meaning of the word when it is changed.	
Digraph	A grapheme made up of two letters.	 sea
Trigraph	A grapheme made up of three letters.	 sigh
Split Digraph	A grapheme with two letters that has another grapheme between them.	 same
Decoding	The translation of the graphemes in a word into phonemes.	S → 
Blending	The blending of phonemes to voice a word.	
Segmenting	The division of a word into individual phonemes.	
Sounding out	The voicing of the individual phonemes in a word.
